Anthea Caddy

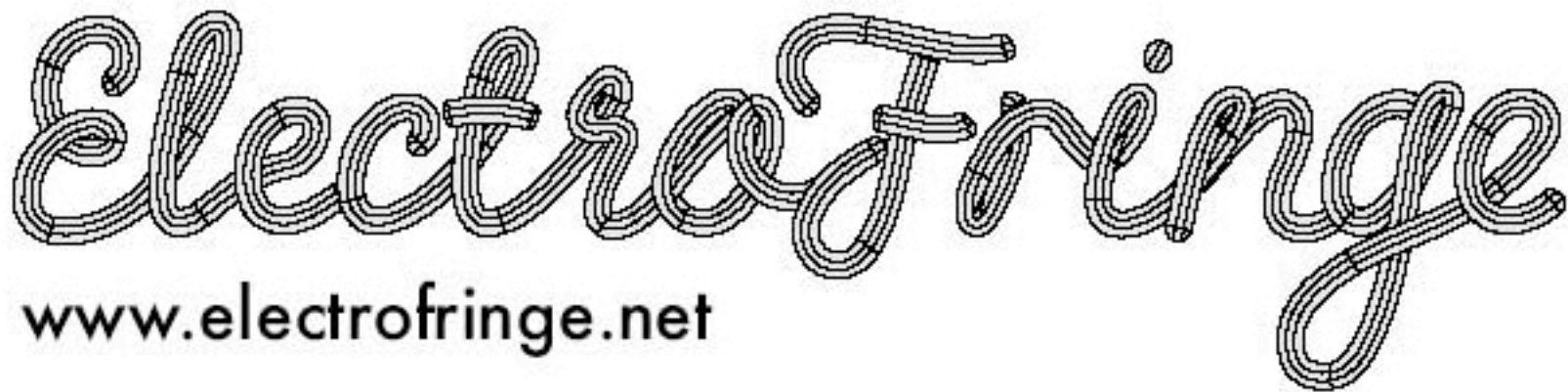
Anthea Caddy plays cello. Her performances explore the intersections and abscesses between free improvisation and composed 'new-music'.
